Get Set For Work

1. Will doing GSFW affect my Centrelink payments?

GSFW is an approved course which allows participants to continue receiving Centrelink payments. Centrelink may require proof of attendance.

2. What happens when I finish the course?

After the course you may choose to work, go to TAFE or return to school. GSFW staff will continue to give you support for a minimum of 3 months after completing the course.

3. Can I join the course part-way through a term?

You can join the course at any time but if it is late in the 10 week cycle you may be advised to wait until the next cycle begins.

4. If I come part-way through a cycle do I only finish that cycle or can I come to the next one as well?

You can continue coming to the program. You may wish to complete 10 weeks or remain for a longer period; the choice is yours.

5. Does this course go towards my Year 10 Certificate?

No it is an approved alternative to senior education, but will not be on your Year10 Certificate.

6. What if I don't really know what I want to do?

One of the aims of GSFW is to help participants develop goals for their future direction by helping them understand where their strengths lie. This course can help you to set a new direction for yourself.
