We are a medium to long term, supported accommodation service for young people aged between 16 and 22 years who are needing support and unable to live at home. Young people accommodated at BABI must have links to the Wynnum/Manly/Redlands area, however we will assist any young people requiring information or support on housing issues.

How do I get a BABI place?

If you need accommodation or would like to refer someone to SAAP, you can:

- call BABI and ask to speak to a Housing Support Worker or
- drop into the BABI office and make a time to meet with a worker from the SAAP team.

If referring someone, it is important that you tell them about BABI and ask that they contact the office to confirm their need for housing assistance.

Other BABI Programs..

Youth Justice Program—works with young people aged 10-17 years who are at risk of becoming involved or becoming further involved in the juvenile justice system.

Family Support Program—provides counselling, parent education, referral and support primarily to families with adolescents and young parents.

Youth Support Co-ordinator Program (YSC's) - work with young people in school from year 4-12 or TAFE equivalent, who are at risk of disengaging from learning for personal or social reasons.

LINX Youth Space—funded by BCC and offers a variety of educational, life skills, recreational workshops and activities for young people aged 12-25 in the Wynnum/Redlands area.

Get Set for Work Program— assists 15-17 year olds who have, or at risk of leaving mainstream education. This program also aims to provide a safety net to re-engage young people in education or work and offer developmental opportunities based on individual needs

Types of SAAP housing

SHARE HOUSES

We have 3 fully furnished share houses that can accommodate up to 4 people at a time. A caretaker lives in a granny flat near the main house and oversees the running of the house.

One of these share houses is a student house. This means that tenants *must* be engaged in education to live here.



INDEPENDENT UNITS

There are 8 fully furnished one-bedroom units to accommodate young people aged between 17-21 years old. A caretaker lives in one of these units and oversees the running of the complex.

SAME HOUSE DIFFERENT LANDLORD

These houses are provided by Department of Housing. We lease these properties to couples and young parents for 6 months. After this time, tenants remain in the house but are signed over to Department of Housing. These properties usually have no fittings or furniture.
